ArcelorMittal Dofasco Community Liaison Committee Terms of Reference (Revision 2: July 2013)

Purpose

The ArcelorMittal Dofasco ("AMD") Community Liaison Committee (CLC) is a forum for the dissemination, review and exchange of information related to the environmental impact of the operations of AMD's facilities in Hamilton.

Membership

The CLC will have a maximum of 20 members including:

At least 5 Citizen Representatives

At least 10 Community Stakeholder Representatives

Bay Area Restoration Council

City of Hamilton Public Health Services

Clean Air Hamilton

Environment Hamilton

Hamilton Chamber of Commerce

Hamilton Conservation Authority

Hamilton Harbour Remedial Action Plan

Hamilton Port Authority

McMaster University

Mohawk College

1 ArcelorMittal Dofasco Representative

General Manager, Environment

1 Ontario Ministry of the Environment (MOE) Representative

District Manager, Hamilton District Office

The Chair will be nominated by the CLC at the first meeting of each year, preferably an independent Chair (i.e. not the AMD or MOE representative).

Committee membership shall be reviewed at the first meeting of the CLC each calendar year, or at the request of a Member. The membership list is intended to be flexible and can be amended by the CLC. Members may notify the Chair of a designate to attend on their behalf.

A constituted meeting requires 9 members in attendance. Any issue requiring a vote of members requires at least 11 members to vote. Voting may be implemented by e-mail response to the Chair who will report voting results to the Committee.

Chairperson: Duties, Roles and Responsibilities

Ensure that meetings are conducted in an efficient, professional and collaborative manner;

Inform members by e-mail when presentations and meeting minutes are posted on the AMD website.

Members: Duties, Roles and responsibilities

Treat all information discussed in a professional and appropriate manner.

Be respectful of the opinion of each member.

Actively engage in a positive dialogue when reviewing any matter before the CLC.

Endeavour to fully understand any matter discussed to enable a fully-informed discussion.

Endeavour to communicate meeting information with their own stakeholder groups.

Propose topics for discussion at future meetings.

Meetings

Meetings will be held quarterly, at times and locations to be most convenient for all members.

Meetings will be open for public comment, with the exception of an *in camera* session at the end of each meeting to enable the Committee to address governance issues or any specific issue raised by a member.

Meetings will be advertised to the public on the AMD website.

AMD shall assume all administrative costs of the meetings.

Effective Date and Acceptance
